The results of these expeditions were never published, and around three-quarters of the monuments in the volume are published here for the first time. All the inscriptions are translated in full, with extensive commentaries and photographic illustration. The volume includes a geographical introduction to the sites and regions covered by the corpus, and full indices.

Peter Thonemann teaches Greek and Roman history at Wadham College, Oxford. He is the author of *The Maeander Valley: A Historical Geography from Antiquity to Byzantium* (Cambridge, 2011), and the editor of *Roman Phrygia: Culture and Society* (Cambridge, 2013), a companion volume to this corpus.
