His scholarly work includes **ARNOLD TOYNBEE AND THE WESTERN TRADITION** (1996); coauthor of **ANTISEMITISM: MYTH AND HATE FROM ANTIQUITY TO THE PRESENT** (2002); coeditor of **ANTISEMITIC MYTHS: A HISTORICAL AND CONTEMPORARY ANTHOLOGY** (2008); and coeditor of **THE THEORY AND PRACTICE OF ISLAMIC TERRORISM: AN ANTHOLOGY** (2008). Dr. Perry's scholarly work focuses on the history of ideas.

Myrna Chase, emerita professor, dean of liberal arts, and provost of Baruch College, City University of New York, is a specialist in 19th and 20th century western European history, with a special interest in England and France and the history of political and social ideas.
