Divided into four sections, the book covers such subjects as sauropods, theropod giants, feathered dinosaurs, the origins of birds, iguanodontids, hadrosaurs, and pterosaurs. The final section of the book also examines non-dinosaurian reptiles of the Mesozoic Era. Holmes, a specialist in natural-history subjects, is thorough, clear, and informative in explaining theories relating to the mass extinction of dinosaurs and other creatures of the time. Chapters conclude with a list of several summary points. Glossary words appear in boldface. Appealing in format and design, the text is supported with abundant color illustrations, charts, and graphs. Appendixes include extensive chapter notes and suggestions for further reading.
